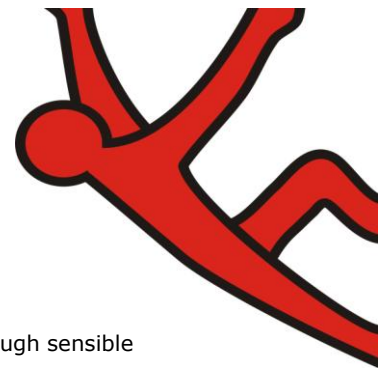


Rules binding for guests at the boulder hall



Personal responsibility and liability

- **The use of the boulder facility is at one's own risk. The guests hold full responsibility!**
- Bouldering can lead to injuries. Even though the owner tries to minimize the risk through sensible behaviour it cannot be fully eliminated.
- As bouldering as well as spotting demands high concentration it is only allowed to stay in the area of a possible fall while spotting.
- A spotter tries to minimize the negative consequences of a fall of a boulderer by using arms and hands. The spotter tries to soften the fall or lead the boulderer in upright posture to the crashpad. Boulderer and spotter need to have about the same body size.
- Every user of the boulder hall needs to be aware of the injury risk, especially when falling down from a great height.
- The users are obliged to inform themselves about further safety arrangements that are not covered by spotting. Users need to observe the instructions from the staff.
- Bouldering without a spotter is not forbidden if the boulderer is aware of the increased risk of injuries in case of a fall.
- The owner does not assume liability in any cases of injuries.
- Every user of the facility is asked to report incorrect behaviour of other guests to the staff or to rebuke them for it.
- The owner does neither assume liability for any objects of value nor personal damage or property damage.
- The users of the facility are asked to have the greatest possible consideration for other guests. Furthermore, users shall not do anything that could lead to endangerment of others.

Registration and use

- You can only use the boulder area after prior registration and buying of a ticket.
- **Children at the age of 6 to 8 are only allowed to use the area with supervision of a legal guardian, an empowered person of full age or if they show a statement of agreement by their parents.**
- Users of the area must follow the instructions of the staff at all times.
- Groups must be registered as such beforehand. The group leader must confirm and ensure that the terms of use are adhered.
- Bouldering is strictly forbidden after drinking alcohol, using narcotics or other drugs.
- Guests must not use the boulder wall with alpine boots. It is allowed to boulder with clean trainers with light soles or special bouldering shoes. Due to hygiene reasons guest must wear clean shoes or slippers at all times while being in the bouldering hall.

Safety instructions

- Before bouldering one must ensure that there is no other climber using the same wall. No more than one person is allowed to climb a boulder at one time.
- The climbing height should be chosen according to one's capability of jumping down and landing safely on the soft bottom.
- It is not allowed to place objects (such as: bags, bottles, etc.) in the landing area.
- **A bouldering wall is not a playground. Children must be supervised at all times.**
- When visiting the boulder hall as part of a group, the members can of course help each other with spotting when jumping down. A spotter cannot be held responsible for injuries of the boulderer.
- It is forbidden to change handholds and steps. Loose structures must be reported to the staff immediately. Users of the bouldering area must be aware of the risk that handholds and steps can turn under pressure and even break. The users bear the risk hereof themselves.

By infringement of the rules guests can be expelled from the area!
